K-12 Public Schools and Community Colleges – State Water Resources Control Board Newly Proposed Municipal Storm Water Permitting for All School Sites

WHY, WHAT AND WHEN OF THE NEWLY PROPOSED REQUIREMENTS WITHIN THE STATEWIDE MUNICIPAL STORM WATER PERMIT

The State Water Resources Control Board will be conducting initial outreach regarding the re-issuance of the Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit allowing discharges to waters of the United States. Public school districts and community college districts within already-permitted municipalities may have storm water discharge requirements in the upcoming statewide permit reissuance. Prior to developing school-specific permit requirements, staff of the State Water Resources Control Board is seeking your input during several outreach sessions held throughout the State.

1. Hear an overview of the proposed permit requirements specific to schools;
2. Ask questions, voice concerns, and provide feedback to State Water Board staff; and
3. Learn about available resources to assist school districts with storm water management.
