Model practices are summary descriptions of the desired results for each LCFF priority and the types of practices and actions that produces these results. This is draft language for the Model Practices suggested for inclusion in the initial phase of the LCFF Evaluation Rubric.

Facilities

Desired Results:

Schools meet state and federal standards for safety, cleanliness, and adequacy, including that the facilities are in good repair and receive regular maintenance. Processes exist to actively track and respond to deficiencies, which may include directing funding to purchase, hire, and/or contract for assistance.

Model Practices:

Model practices may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Develop a Facilities Master Plan to better understand current and long-term facility needs;
- Implementation of regular preventive maintenance as a cornerstone to an effective maintenance initiative.
- Ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act
- Upgrade cafeteria and kitchen facilities to ensure students have access to nutritious, quality meals;
